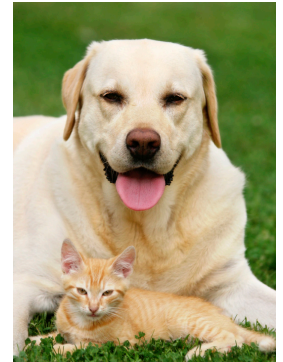

LEARN ABOUT ANIMAL LAWS • “ASK THE VETERINARIAN”**

The DC Department of Health Animal Services Program will be hosting the 2016 Animal Health Fairs throughout April, May and June. Our program provides free vaccinations to dogs and cats for residents of the District of Columbia.

Before You Come, You Need to Know That:

- All pets must be brought to the clinic by a responsible adult.
- Dogs must be secured on a leash and cats must be secured in a carrier box.
- The law requires that all dogs are registered and wear their tags on their collars.
- Dog license is \$15 for a spayed or neutered dog and \$50 for an unspayed or unneutered dog.*
- Dogs over the age of four (4) months old are required by law to be vaccinated against rabies and distemper. Cats are required to be vaccinated against rabies only.
- If available, please bring previous vaccination history.
- Maximum 4 pets per owner.

*AT THE ANIMAL HEALTH FAIR, YOU CAN PAY BY **CHECK OR MONEY ORDER (PAYABLE TO: DC TREASURER)**. NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.

During the Fair, You Need to Know That:

- All pets must be brought to the clinic by a responsible adult.
- Dogs must be secured on a leash and cats must be secured in a carrier box.
- Free vaccines will be provided.
- Dogs over the age of four (4) months old are required by law to be vaccinated against rabies and distemper. Cats are required to be vaccinated against rabies only.
- The law requires that all dogs are registered and wear their tags on their collars.
- Dog licensing will be provided.
- Dog license is \$15 for a spayed or neutered dog and \$50 for an unspayed or unneutered dog.*
- Maximum 4 pets per owner.
