

## MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES CURRENTLY OPEN

A medical marijuana dispensary is a facility operated by an organization or business registered with the Department of Health. A dispensary may possess and dispense medical marijuana and paraphernalia to patients and caregivers registered with the Department of Health. This is done in a secure retail setting. All medical marijuana sold in dispensaries will be provided by approved cultivators located within the District.

### Change of Dispensary

Patients must be registered to one (1) medical marijuana dispensary. Patients may change the dispensary they wish to be registered with by providing fourteen (14) calendar days written notice to the Department on a “Change of Information Form.” This form is available on the Department’s Medical Marijuana Program webpage: <http://doh.dc.gov/mmp>. There is a \$90 fee to replace the patient registration card. (DCMR 22-C §200.8)

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The United States Congress has determined that marijuana is a controlled substance and has placed marijuana in Schedule I of the Controlled Substance Act. Growing, distributing, and possessing marijuana in any capacity, other than as a part of a federally authorized research program, is a violation of federal laws. The District of Columbia’s law authorizing the District’s medical marijuana program will not excuse any person from any violation of the federal laws governing marijuana or authorize any registrant to violate federal laws.
