Dispensary Provisional Scores At Least 150 Points

Medical Marijuana Program

The Selection Process for Medical Marijuana Dispensaries is described in 22 DCMR C § 5402. In compliance with these regulations a six (6) member panel was convened consisting of one (1) representative from the Department of Health (DOH), District Department of the Environment (DDOE), Office of the Attorney General (OAG), Department of Real Estate Services Protective Services Division (PSD), the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs (DCRA), and a representative of the general public (or patient advocate), selected by the Director of the Department of Health, to evaluate and score each application. Prior to seeking Area Neighborhood Commissioner (ANC) review, the panel calculated a provisional score based upon the then available points and bonus points.

As outlined in 22 DCMR C § 5402, provisional scores were calculated by discarding the highest and lowest panel member scores, adding up the four (4) remaining scores, and dividing that total by four (4). As required under the regulations, the provisional scores were ranked below from highest to lowest and not more than the ten (10) highest ranking cultivation center applicants were provisionally selected. To be considered eligible for further review, an application must have at least one hundred and fifty (150) points prior to the ANC review.
