- 3. Records adequate and current
- 4. Reporting Illness, Accidents

Postings

- 5. Appropriate warnings and prohibitions
- 6. Emergency phone numbers
- 7. Rules
- 8. Licenses and permits

Safety Equipment

- Ring buoy with adequate rope
- 10. 12 foot pole
- 11. Backboard and 2 blankets
- 12 First aid kit
- 13. Elevated lifeguard platform or chairs
- 14. Lifesaving equipment properly located
- 15. Emergency care area, telephone

Bathhouse

- 16. Floors: clean, in good repair
- 17. Walls & ceilings: clean, in good repair
- 18. Adequate lighting and ventilation
- Plumbing: no leaks, adequate supply of warm water to showers and hand basins
- 20. Plumbing: no cross-connections
- 21. Plumbing fixtures: clean, in good repair
- Plumbing fixtures: Adequate toilets, urinals, hand basins and showers
- Dressing and Sanitary Facilities: Furnished suits & towels: properly washed and disinfected
- Adequate supplies: Soap & soap dispensers, toilet tissue, receptacles (showers & sinks)

Deck & Pool

- 25. Lighting: approved wiring and fixtures
- 26. Adequate lighting and fixtures in good repair
- Diving board: approved, properly secured, adequate, and in good repair
- Ladders & steps: adequate, properly secured, in good repair, slip-resistant treads
- Depth markings: plainly marked, appropriately located
- 30. Drinking fountain: present, clean, good repair

Deck & Pool (con't)

- 31. Decks & walkways: sufficient width, good repair, clean, properly drained, impervious and with a slip-resistant surface
- 32. Pool side & bottom: clean, good repair no algae
- 33. Bathing load: safety standards observed
- Fencing & gates: properly constructed, in good repair, sufficient height, appropriate latches & locks
- 35. Spectators: excluded from deck and pool area
- 36. Food & beverage: excluded from deck and pool area

Premises

- 37. Drainage: no standing water or muddy areas
- Refuse storage: appropriate containers used, litter properly containerized
- 39. Equipment access and security
- 40. Physical facilities clean, in good repair


Water Treatment & Equipment

- Water level: sufficient for maintaining a continuous skimming action
- Skimmers: weirs present and functioning, basket in place
- 43. Scum gutter: clean and free flowing
- Filter room: clean, adequate lighting, drained, vented
- 45. Piping: no cross connections
- 46. Piping: hair and lint catchers
- 47. Piping: grates over deck and pool drains
- 48. Filters & pumps: good repair, operating, air relief valve, flow meter, pressure gauges
- Disinfectant & chemical feeders: disinfectant and other chemical feeder in good repair and operating
- Vacuum cleaning equipment: present, in good repair
- Chemicals: properly stored, properly used, sufficient quantity on hand
- Test kits: appropriate and usable pH and disinfectant measuring equipment available
- 53. Water Quality, Source, & Temperature
- 54. Other: Pest Control

In addition, the following items will be check:

Deep end free Chlorine residual
