

Items to be considering during Swimming pool and/or Spa inspections

Personnel

1. Licensed Pool Operator on duty
2. Qualified Lifeguard on duty

Records

1. Records adequate and current

Postings

1. Appropriate warnings and prohibitions
2. Emergency phone numbers
3. Rules
4. Licenses and permits

Safety Equipment

1. Ring buoy with adequate rope
2. 12 inch pole
3. Cot and 2 blankets
4. First aid kit
5. Elevated lifeguard platform or chairs
6. Life saving equipment properly located
7. Emergency care area, telephone

Bathhouse

1. Floors: clean, in good repair
2. Walls & ceilings: clean, in good repair
3. Adequate lighting and ventilation
4. Plumbing: approved construction
5. Plumbing: no leaks, adequate supply of warm water to showers and hand basins
6. Plumbing: no cross-connections
7. Plumbing fixtures: clean, in good repair
8. Plumbing fixtures: Adequate toilets, urinals, hand basins and toilet tissue
9. Furnished suits & towels: properly washed and disinfected
10. Soap & soap dispensers (showers)
11. Soap & paper towels (sinks)

Deck & Pool

1. Lighting: approved wiring and fixtures
2. Adequate lighting and fixtures in good repair
3. Diving board: approved, properly secured, adequate, and in good repair
4. Ladders & steps: adequate, properly secured, in good repair, slip-resistant treads
5. Depth markings: plainly marked, appropriately located
6. Life line: present, adequate
7. Drinking fountain: present, clean, good repair
8. Decks & walkways: sufficient width, good repair, clean, properly drained, impervious and with a slip-resistant surface
9. Pool side & bottom: clean, good repair, no algae
10. Bathing load: safety standards observed
11. Fencing & gates: properly constructed, in good repair, sufficient height, appropriate latches & locks
12. Spectators: excluded from deck and pool area
13. Food & beverage: excluded from deck and pool area

Premises

1. Drainage: no standing water or muddy areas
2. Refuse storage: appropriate containers used, litter properly containerized

Water Treatment & Equipment

1. Water level: sufficient for maintaining a continuous skimming action
2. Skimmers: weirs present and functioning, basket in place
3. Scum gutter: clean and free flowing
4. Filter room: clean, adequate lighting, drained, vented
5. Piping: no cross connections
6. Piping: hair and lint catchers
7. Piping: grates over deck and pool drains
8. Filters & pumps: good repair, operating, air relief valve, flow meter, pressure gauges
9. Disinfectant & chemical feeders: disinfectant feeder in good repair and operating
10. Disinfectant & chemical feeders: other chemical feeds in good repair
11. Vacuum cleaning equipment: present, in good repair
12. Chemicals: properly stored, properly used, sufficient quantity on hand
13. Test kits: appropriate and usable pH and disinfectant measuring equipment available
