The mission of the Commission on Judicial Disabilities and Tenure (CJDT) is to preserve an independent and fair judiciary.


SUMMARY OF SERVICES

The services provided by the Tenure Commission are as follows: reviewing complaints concerning the misconduct of judges; conducting performance evaluations of associate judges eligible for reappointment; conducting fitness and qualification reviews of retiring and senior judges; and processing the involuntary retirement of judges for health reasons

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ✓ The Commission successfully launched its website in FY2011. All of the narrative links were re-drafted and re-formatted to provide more information about the Commission and to make the website more accessible and user friendly. In addition, anyone wishing to file a complaint with the Commission can now do so electronically via the website.
- ✓ The Commission with the assistance of OCTO, DCNET, and the IT Division of the D.C. Courts was able to upgrade its computer connections, and now has access to the D.C. Lan and the D.C. Server. This upgrade has provided a time and cost effective process by which employees can access the PASS System, PeopleSoft, Payment Net, and SOAR.

-  **INITIATIVE 3.2: Upgrade computer connections.**
Fully Achieved This initiative was accomplished in FY 2011. The Commission is now connected to the D.C. Server, and has access to the D.C. Lan, thereby making internet and computer connections more cost and time efficient.
