This amendment will now require the reporting of pregnancy in HIV-infected women to the Department of Health. This change is being made so that we can ensure the health of pregnant women, prevent the transmission of a communicable disease and offer any medical and/or social services they may require. The full text of the amendment will be available in the D.C. Municipal Regulation and D.C. Register.</p>
