OS-0614-01	<p><u>OPEN SESSION MINUTES</u> The Board approved the Open Session Minutes of the May 10, 2017, meeting.</p>	
OS-0614-02	<p><u>CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT</u> Dr. Vidale reported on his experience with x-ray for imaging orders. Dr. Vidale also discussed details of the upcoming PT Forum including announcements and invites for speakers.</p>	
OS-0614-03	<p><u>EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT</u> Ms. Jenkins informed the Board that the PT Forum will be held on October 6, 2017, at 9:00 am the Mayor Press Briefing Room, in the Wilson Building and shared draft reminder, save the date notices that will be sent to the licensees. Invites for the PT forum will be sent to the Mayor and all City Council members. Ms. Jenkins also informed the Board of the "Latest News" notifications that will be sent to licensees informing them of Board actions, activities and news. Ms. Jenkins informed the Board that the Physical Therapy Compact Commission (PTCC) is an official entity as of June 14, 2017, which elected its Board members and will develop by-laws and operational rules for PT Compact members. The purpose of this compact is to facilitate, interstate practice of Physical Therapy with the goal of improving public access to Physical services. They (PTCC) expect to be fully operational early in 2018. There are thirteen states that have signed on to the PT Compact and two are expected to join before the end of the year. There have been four states that have started some legislation that has not passed at this time.</p>
