POLICY ON
TEMPORARY SUPERVISED PRACTICE FOR
PENDING CHIROPRACTIC APPLICANTS


Pursuant to District of Columbia Municipal Regulation (DCMR) §17-4805.7, an applicant approved for an initial license to sit for the next scheduled exam may request the Board's permission to practice under the supervision of a District licensed chiropractor until results of the exam are posted.

The Board of Chiropractic's formulated policy for temporary supervised practice for pending applicants of the District of Columbia will be as follows:

REQUIREMENTS

- All Applicants:
- (1) The applicant shall work under the direct supervision of chiropractor approved by the Board.
 - (2) The applicant shall possess a chiropractic license in another jurisdiction.
 - (3) The temporary supervised practice shall not exceed 6 months.
 - (4) The temporary license may not be renewed or extended for any purpose.
 - (5) Upon failing the Jurisprudence Exam twice, an applicant may no longer practice under the supervision of a chiropractor as allowed under DCMR §17-4805.7.

This policy shall be effective immediately.
