	<p><u>MTL Approval/Renewal Update</u> Mr. Meyers provided the Board with an update on the status of the remaining MTL renewals. Staff has been in constant contact with the various Graduate Medical Education programs on the status of the outstanding MTL applications and has provided updated reports.</p> <p><u>IT Issues and Renewal</u> The Executive Director discussed the renewal glitches with the IT department, and is hopeful they will be resolved by October for a full license renewal cycle.</p> <p><u>Board Emails and Passes</u> The Executive Director updated the Board on the status of their building passes, emails, and parking.</p> <p>C. BOARD ATTORNEY'S REPORT The Board Attorney had no report for the Open Session.</p> <p>Motion: The above reports were provided for informational purposes only. No formal action was taken.</p>

The report included a proposal to change existing regulations to require certain physicians to undergo re-testing to ensure proper patient care is being provided.</p> <p>Following discussion the Board requested additional research on the issue of aging physicians, including contacting both the Federation for State Medical Board (FSMB) and the Illinois Board on existing regulations.</p> <p>Motion: The above item was provided for informational purposes only. No formal action was taken.</p>	



OS-16-048	<p><u>FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM APPROVAL REQUEST</u></p> <p>Board Action: The Board considered the approval request for the Georgetown University Hospital (GUH) Multiorgan Transplant and Hepatobiliary Surgery Fellowship program. The program is not accredited by the ACGME or the AOA, but is accredited by the ASTS.</p> <p>Background: As the GUH Multiorgan Transplant and Hepatobiliary Surgery Fellowship program is not approved and accredited by the ACGME, applicants cannot be approved for an MTL license to practice in this program. The only way applicants can be granted a license is if the Board approves the program, which the Board previously did, however said approval lapsed in 2015.</p> <p>Updated program information was presented for the Board’s review and approval.</p> <p>Motion: Motion made by Dr. Smith to approve the program for another two (2) years. Seconded by Dr. Anderson.</p> <p>Dr. Orlowski, Dr. Manning, Dr. Anderson, Dr. Rankin, Dr. Fripp, Mr. Dawson, Dr. Smith, Mr. Straub, and Ms. Johnson voted in favor of the motion. This has included a review and discussion of the 2016 renewal forms for physician and physician assistants, the 2016 Workforce Survey for physicians and physician assistants, and the physician profile.</p> <p>Recently, staff met with SA to discuss timelines and steps to successfully complete this process.
