ADDENDUM TO THE AESTHETIC MEDICINE GUIDELINES

Facilities providing aesthetic services have been categorized into 3 levels based on the level of risk involved in the procedures that are provided, services that may be provided, and the licensed professionals who may perform those services.

Licensed Practitioners may perform procedures only in level(s) consistent with their scope.

Level I=Low Risk* Spa or Salon.

Level II=Moderate Risk**

Level III=High Risk**

***Use of 'Med' or 'Medi' in marketing or advertising a level 1 facility or services is prohibited.**

****Level II and Level III facilities are considered Medispas, and individuals who perform procedures in those facilities are regulated by the DC Board of Medicine.**

The facilities are regulated by the DC Department of Health and DCRA.

WHERE: Type of facility and rules/guidelines around operation.
WHO: Who can perform services - type of health professional.
WHAT: Type/Category of procedures permitted.
