	<u>Chairperson's Report:</u> Ms. Robin Jenkins updated the Board that the Mayor's Office for Talents and Appointments (MOTA) is actively searching to replace the vacancies on the Board. The City Council Oversight hearing will be coming up soon and the department is currently working on preparing data for the hearing she advised the Board chair to prepare to attend and present a testimony on behalf of the Board. 	Board's Attorney's Report: The Board attorney reported that the Health Care Reporting Bill had been expanded to include employers. The Department of Health is also working on changing the Criminal Background Check requirements to make it easier for licensees and prospective applicants in the District. Finally there has been an introduction of a bill: Removing Barriers to Occupational Licensing -B22-0523 requiring that Boards may not use criminal background check reports that did not result in convictions to deny a license application and how this bill may adversely impact the operation of the Boards.
