DC ORR Employment Program

This program helps refugees and asylees to effectively integrate themselves in the American work ethic and culture and achieve self-sufficiency through early employment by providing services such as:

- Job Club sessions held Fridays from 10 am -1:30 pm that orients refugees and asylees to American work ethic, culture and customs. Attendance is required.
- Job Referrals meet with staff to get the latest information on job openings from various employers.
- Information & Referrals information for English classes, vocational training, refugee health screening, and other community resources.

The Refugee Center programs and services are funded by the DC Office of Refugee Resettlement (DCORR) and through private donations and charitable contributions.

- Be a DC resident and show proof of residency.
- Be 100% motivated to seek employment and work with staff for assistance
